MEDICAL

Kootenai County Assistance

- ❖ 446-1888
 - Court house/DMV building on the 2nd floor
 - They can provide medical coverage for patients without insurance if certain criteria are met.
 - Application must be filled out within 30 days of accident. There is also an interview the patient is required to go to.

Department of Health and Welfare

- ❖ Medicaid 769-1456
 - In order to be eligible, there must be a qualifying minor in the household or the patient must be on disability.
 - Medicaid can sometimes go back as far as 3 months.

CareCredit

- ❖ CareCredit is a medical visa that the physician pays the interest on up to 12 months.
 - Applications can be picked up at the office, applied for online @ www.carecredit.com or applied for by phone at 800.365.8295.

Kootenai County Assistance

- ❖ Need to fill out an application within 30 days of accident for assistance
 - They can provide money for rent if patient bring in an eviction notice

Mortgage companies can sometimes put 3 months mortgage at the end of the loan term if patient calls and has documentation of accident and a statement for their work they have nothing the patient can do until they get better.

Landlords of rentals will sometimes divide the rent up after 3 month to help patients out of work with documentation.

Health insurance (ei: bc/bs) sometimes include short term disability.
